

Wall Hung Installation Guide

IMPORTANT:

Ensure appropriate structural support behind the finished wall, such as reinforced backing or stud noggins, to securely mount basins and other wall-hung fixtures.

1. Marking Height

- Mark the finished top height, accounting for approx. -13mm to allow for bracket height (verify bracket height before installation). See Fig. 1.
- Draw a level line at the top bracket height on the wall.

2. Centre Alignment

- · Measure and mark the centreline on the wall for top placement.
- · Mark the centreline on the mounting bracket.

3. Bracket Mounting

- Position the mounting bracket on the wall and mark the MUST-DO fixing points for drilling (refer to image).
- · Use the following fixing guide:
 - · 250mm, 500mm, 650mm, 800mm brackets: Two fixing points.
 - 1050mm bracket: Three fixing points.
- Ensure the fixing points are as close as possible to the threaded rod on the bracket. See Fig. 2.

4. Drilling

- Drill 10mm holes through tiles at the marked points.
- Pre-drill 6.5mm holes for coach bolts. See Fig. 3 for a completed installation.

Timber: Use M8 x 75mm coach bolts. Masonry: Use 8mm x 60mm Anka/Dyna bolts.

5. Bracket Installation: Secure the bracket to the wall.

6. Top Installation

- · Guide the moulded top onto the threaded rod.
- · Place the large washer first, followed by the smaller washer, and finally the nut.
- · Use packers for adjustment, if necessary.
- 7. Fit taps and waste assemble to basin.

Optional - Shroud Mount Installation.

- Mount the shroud bracket onto the wall (refer to image).
- Ensure the basin is securely fixed and connected.
- Slide the shroud gently into place and tighten it with the appropriate size bolts at two positions.
